Purposes of data processing:

mail address, or address) of a person per household

Participation in the tour is only possible by submitting
this contact information.

Legal basis for processing:

Your contact details are processed based on the
protection and hygiene concept of Bayerische
Staatsgemäldesammlungen and your consent in
accordance with article 6 letter a GDPR in conjunction
with the 5th Infection Protection Measures Ordinance
Bavaria.

Recipients of the personal data:

A transmission of this information is allowed only for
the purpose of providing information on request to the
responsible health authorities. Please note that if your
data is requested by the responsible health authority,
you must also provide the data of the other
participants in your household.

Duration of data processing:

Your data will be automatically deleted one month
after your visit to our building.

Your rights:

You have a right to information from the person
responsible for your personal data.
You have the right to have your personal data
corrected.
You have the right to delete, also parts of, your
personal data.
You have the right to restrict your personal data.
You have the right to object to the processing of your
personal data.
You have the right to data portability of your personal
data.
You have the right to revoke your consent at any time
without giving reasons, without affecting the legality of
the processing carried out based on the consent up to
the revocation.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with our
